A message on Pupil Transportation/ Bus Etiquette/ School Closing

Here at Pathways we take pride in providing a safe and reliable transportation for our students each day. To provide this level of service, we depend on our caring and skilled drivers and the cooperation, commitment, and respect of our parents and students.

Please remember the following:

If your child will not be going to the school bus stop, please contact the school as soon as possible.

To insure students don't miss the bus, please arrive 5-10 minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time. Parents are required to wait at the bus stop until students have safely boarded the bus. Their pick-up person should also be on time.

While waiting for the bus, students should remain on the sidewalk or in public areas for safety. Students should not congregate on/inside buildings, lawns, driveways, or other public or private property. Uses of the pick-up point buildings are limited to the bathrooms and drinking fountains if needed.

Please do not litter while waiting and please keep noise to a minimum: speaking in conversational tones should not disturb others; however, yelling can be bothersome.

Bus Pick-up

Students **MUST** load the Student First bus at one of the two bus stops. This is the only route of transportation for students onto base. Children must be to the pick-up points on time; drivers are not allowed to pull over at undesignated locations.

Exceptions for student transportation to school can **ONLY** be made for extreme emergencies. At which case, Mr. Stanford or Mrs. Hebel will have to pre-announce student's parent/legal guardian **ONLY** to transport their child onto base.

- South End Bus Stop: Warren Woods Administration Building
12900 Frazho Road in Warren
Pick-up is at 7:30-7:40 am. Drop off is at 3:30.
- North End Bus Stop: Glen Peters School
46650 Heydenreich Road in Clinton Township
Pick-up is at 8:10-8:15. Drop off is at 3:05.

Cell Phones and Electronic Equipment:

Students may bring a cellular phone or electronic device to school. During school hours and on all school vehicles, they must be off, not in use, and out of sight. Possession of these devices by a student is a privilege, which may be forfeited by any student who fails to abide by the terms of the policy or otherwise engages in misuse of the privilege. Violations of the policy may result in disciplinary action against the student, which may result in confiscation of the device, suspension, or expulsion. Those who possess these devices shall assume responsibility for its care. At no time, shall the school or district be responsible for preventing theft, loss, or damage to the equipment brought to its property.

School Closings:

School closings will be reported to the television stations- channel 4 and 7. If weather closure includes L'Anse Creuse School District, the Pathways School will also be closed. If school is not cancelled and inclement weather arrives, busses may be late.

If Macomb Area Pathways must cancel school due to building problems, parents/guardian will be contacted via phone. Please be certain MAP always has updated contact information for each child.

Due to our alternative setting, MAP may have to cancel school due to staffing issues – we do not call in substitutes. If such problem arises, you will be notified via phone or letterhead document.
